Despite the death sentence that one of the doctors tried to give her, she never gave up believing that our God is a healer and He proved himself faithful in all areas of our life.

From our short time in Ireland, to our time in Africa, we believe that we are going to see Him do things differently than we have seen them before. Femi and his Bible School have trained up missionaries to: Northern Nigeria, Niger, Mauritania, Mali, Burkina Faso, Djibouti, Darfur, and Ghana. 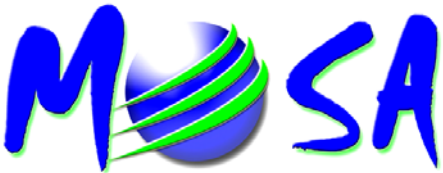
